



DKV expands acceptance network in Denmark

Mobility service provider connects 160 Go'on brand self-service petrol stations

Ratingen, 06.11.2020. DKV customers in Denmark can now also obtain fuel without cash at 160 Go'on self-service stations. The unmanned petrol stations are accessible around the clock. The expansion brings the number of DKV acceptance points in Denmark to over 1,330 stations. This corresponds to a network coverage of around 60 percent. Every year, the mobility service provider connects around 5,000 petrol stations throughout Europe, with a strong focus on multi-energy filling stations that offer alternative fuels such as CNG and LPG in addition to conventional fuels.
